Some Helpful Hints

- **We will not take Latex Paint.** Solidified latex paint may be placed out with weekly trash. Latex paint cans have been dried out. Allow paint to dry to a solid before placing in a trash bag for pickup.
- Pack materials in a cardboard box for transport to avoid spills.
- Leave products in their original containers.
